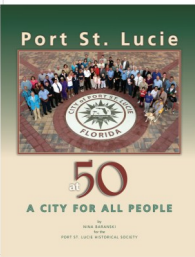

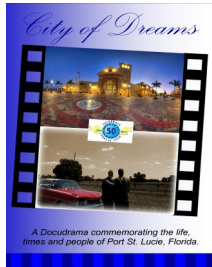
Port St. Lucie at 50:
